हर वर्ष 26 जनवरी को हमारे देश में गणतंत्र दिवस के रूप में मनाया जाता है। हम सभी देशवासियों को भारत का नागरिक होने का गर्व है। 26 जनवरी 1950 को हमारा देश एक प्रजातान्त्रिक गणतंत्र देश बना था। इस दिन हमारे देश में संविधान लागू हुआ था। हमारी मातृभूमि भारत लंबे समय तक ब्रिटिश शासन की गुलाम रही तथा ब्रिटिश शासन द्वारा बनाये गये कानूनों का भारतीय लोगों को पालन करना पड़ता था व कानूनों को मानने के लिये मजबूर थे, भारतीय स्वतंत्रता सेनानियों द्वारा लंबे संघर्ष के बाद भारतीय स्वतंत्रता सेनानियों ने अंततः 15 अगस्त, 1947 को भारत को आजादी दिलाई। लगभग 2 साल 11 महीने 18 दिन बाद 26 जनवरी 1950 को हमारी संसद द्वारा भारतीय संविधान पारित किया गया। भारत ने अपना संविधान लागू किया और खुद को संप्रभु, लोकतांत्रिक, गणराज्य के रूप में घोषित किया। भारत में आजादी के बाद 'विविधता में एकता' के अस्तित्व को दिखाने के लिए देश के अलग-अलग राज्य खूबसूरत झांकियों के ज़रिए अपनी संस्कृति, परंपरा और प्रगति को दिखाते हैं। अतः यह और भी आवश्यक हो जाता है कि इस विशेष दिन को हम उचित सम्मान दें और इसे साथ मिलकर मनाये, जिससे हमारे देश की एकता और अखंडता जिसके लिए कई वीरों ने अपने प्राणों की आहुति दी है, इसी प्रकार से बनी रहे। गणतंत्र दिवस का यह राष्ट्रीय पर्व हमारे लिए बहुत ही महत्वपूर्ण है क्योंकि हमारे देश का संविधान तथा इसका गणतांत्रिक स्वरूप ही हमारे देश को कश्मीर से कन्याकुमारी तक जोड़ने का कार्य करता है।
